# For the trip

- **Luggage:**
  - One Rucksack/holdall – with item list inside\*
  - One small backpack, to contain a water bottle, pen, pencil, paper, waterproof coat and SUN CREAM LOTION. Also pack lunch (no extras)
  - Roll mat
  - Sleeping bag
  - Pillow
  - Eye mask- the sun rises early!
  - Watch(?) (not a smart one!)
- **Clothing for journey:**
  - The children should wear outdoor ready clothes. They may wear leggings, trousers/tracksuit and suitable shoes.



# For the trip

- Clothes should be comfortable, consider lots of old clothes - you will definitely end up getting a bit mucky so don't bring anything too precious! Please ensure all are clearly labelled with your child's name.
- Hat and waterproof
- Thermals
- Nightwear – Pyjamas, eye mask
- Underwear – 4 days' supply
- Socks – 4 days' supply
- Tops – Polo shirts, T Shirts etc (3 +)
- Jumper – Warm sweatshirt or jumper, (2+)
- Trousers – joggers, leggings, tracksuit (3+)
- Footwear – comfortable shoes for walking and doing outdoor physical activities (not brand-new ones), wellies/walking boots
- Towels – 1 bath towel
- Toiletries in washbag – soap, flannel, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, hairbrush/comb, roll on deodorant and sun cream lotion.
- Torch



# Please note

- If your child requires any medication, please could you come and pick up a medication request form from the school office. With the exception of Paracetamol, all medicines for residential trips must be prescribed.
- All medications (eg: for asthma, hay fever, eczema, nut allergy etc) including ibuprofen must be prescribed. They must be in-date, pharmacy labelled, provided in the original container as dispensed by a pharmacist and include instructions for administration, dosage and storage.
- Ensure all medical forms are returned before the deadline!
