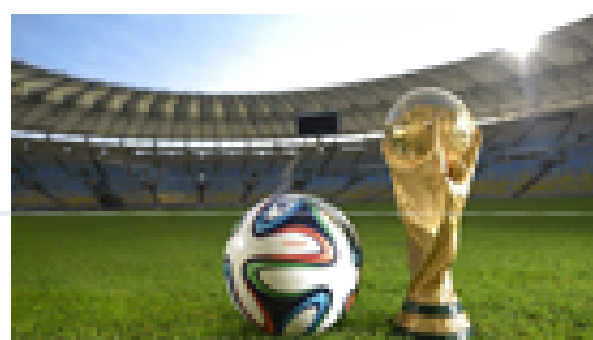

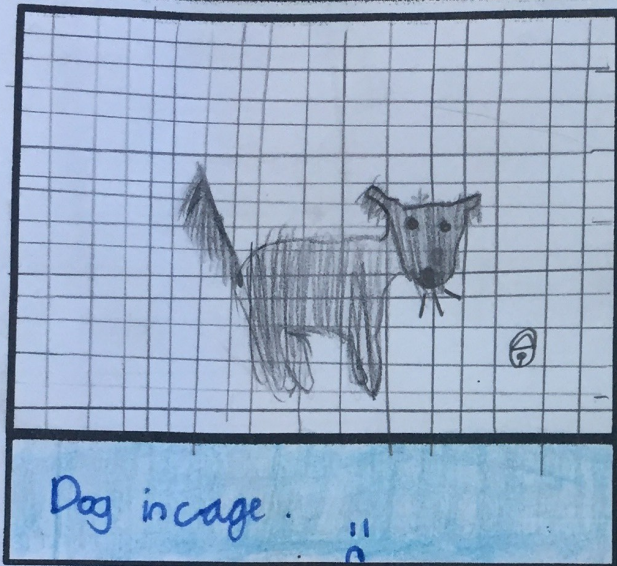
Next week, Year 2 are going to go on a trip to Brighton and there will be a sea life shop there. We are al-

is give them a free, warm thank you. Manners are free– use them!

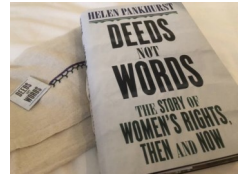

Her name was Millicent Fawcett.

*Fawcett founded a political cam-

for women. They did things like:*

*Chain themselves to the houses of
Parliament, handcuff themselves to

Emmeline Pankhurst.

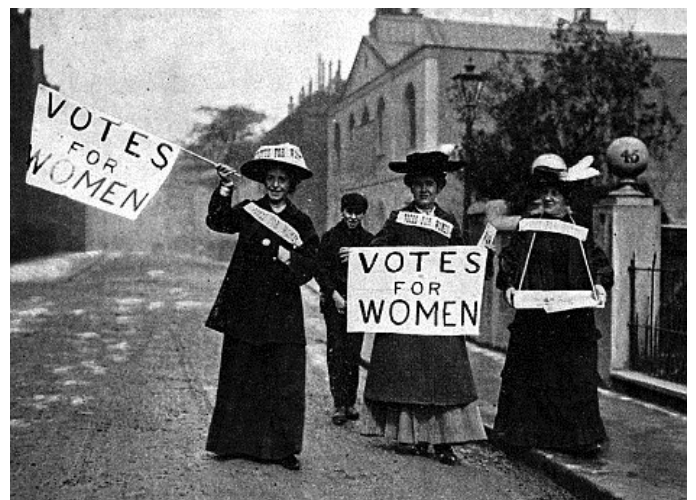
