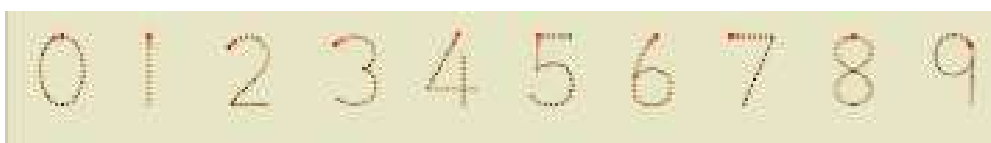
Capital Letters:
