



## SCHOOL MEALS

Currently the Government provides “Universal Free School Meals” for all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. This entitles all children *in those year groups* to have a school meal, free of charge, whilst they are at school. However, you do have the option to provide a packed lunch for your child if you wish. All parents are asked please to complete the attached form registering for meals or packed lunches. This should be returned at the next Induction session. Thank you.

### School lunch menu

A copy of the lunch menu is published in the School’s Weekly News each week. There is always a vegetarian option as well as the option for a baked potato and a salad bar is also available each day together with freshly baked bread. We think our meals are excellent – just ask Mr Lewin!
