



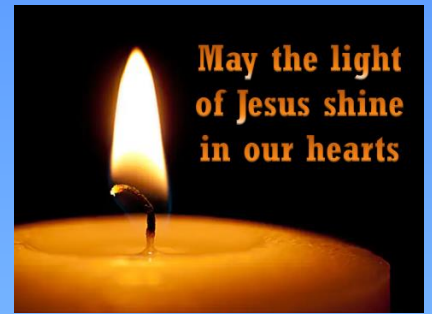
PRAYERS FOR WHEN LEARNING AT HOME

Lord,

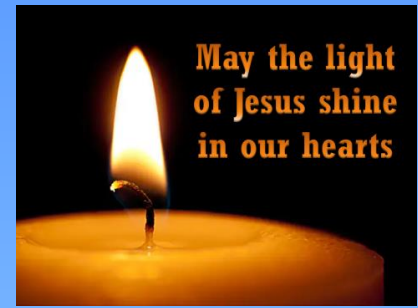
bless us all today and be with our families in.

Tuesday 5th May



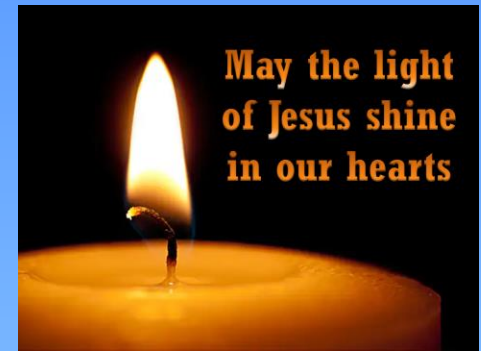
Our Father

Wednesday 6th May



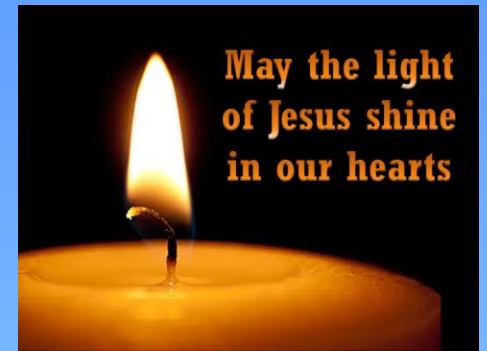
Think of our Golden Rule- how we need to treat other people. Our Golden Threads show us how we should live our lives.

We thank you for the people who fought for us. We pray for people whose lives are still affected by war today. We pray for peace for our world.

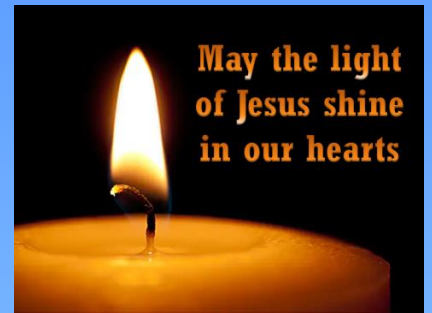

And love - not hate.

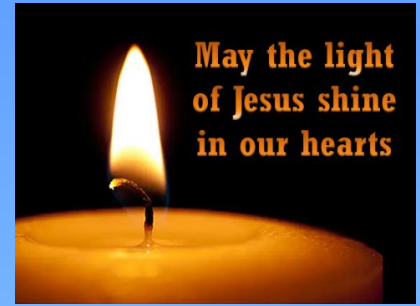
Then we will have hope for a better future together.

Tuesday 12th May

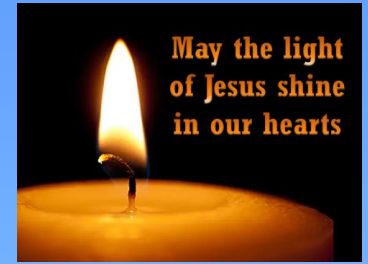


Hail Mary, full of grace,

Wednesday 13th May



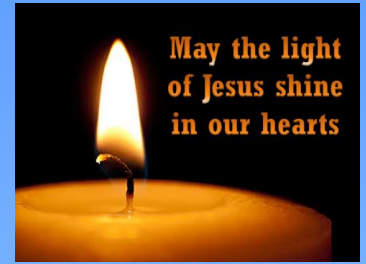
Think of our friends in Busenya- can you think of ways their lives are similar to yours and how they might be different?

The Short Gloria

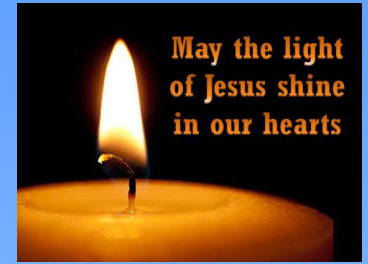
**Glory be to the Father,

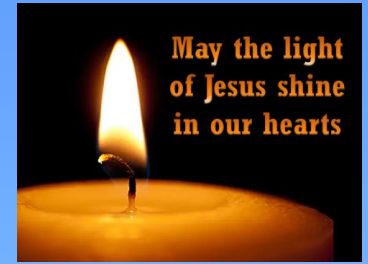




WEEK SEVEN



Monday 18th May



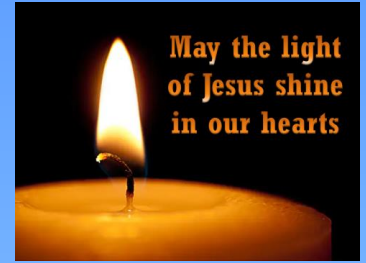
Sometimes when we think of the many other children in our world we can wonder how God can love them all, one by one. But he does because he is God.

bring your peace**

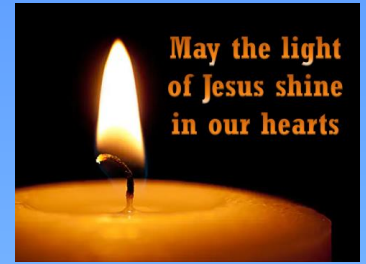
**Where there is darkness, let me

use our talents,

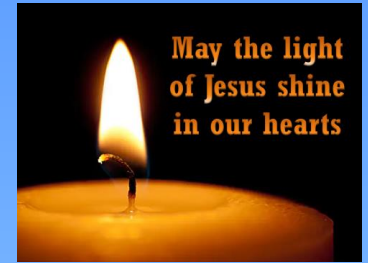
remember important things,

Help us not to ruin it.

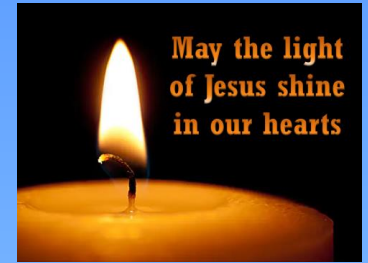
God bless *here*.
