Like the Heavens up above.

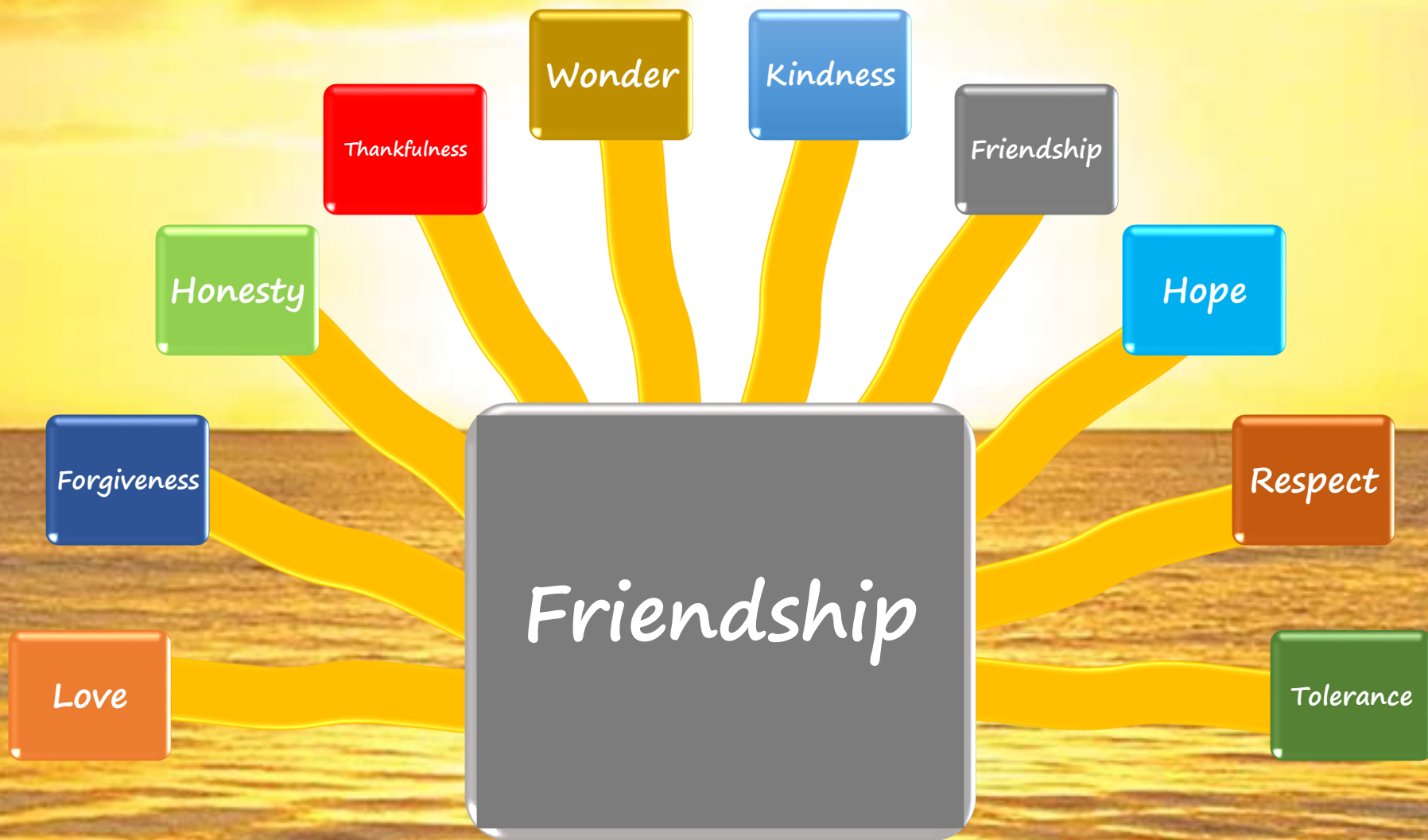



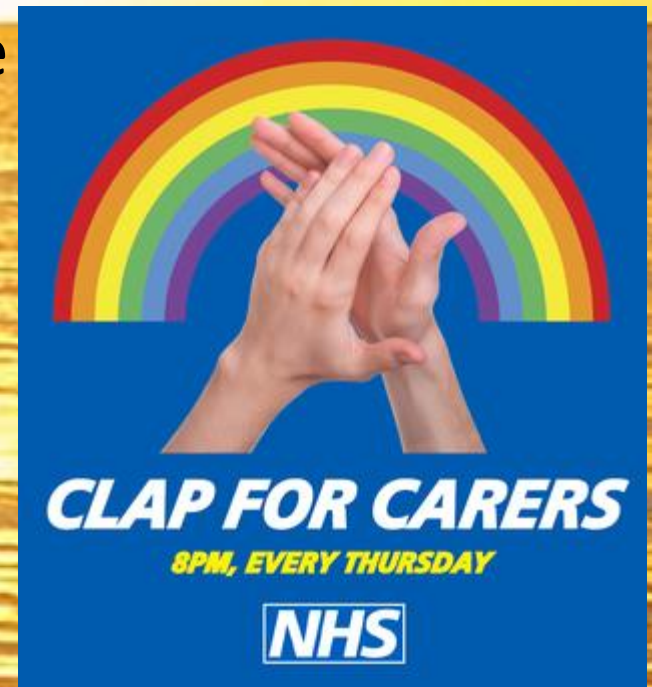


Each Thursday we show our respect and gratitude for all the essential workers by clapping at 8 o'clock. It is a way of saying thank you for all they do for us.

We can show our respect by saying thank you.

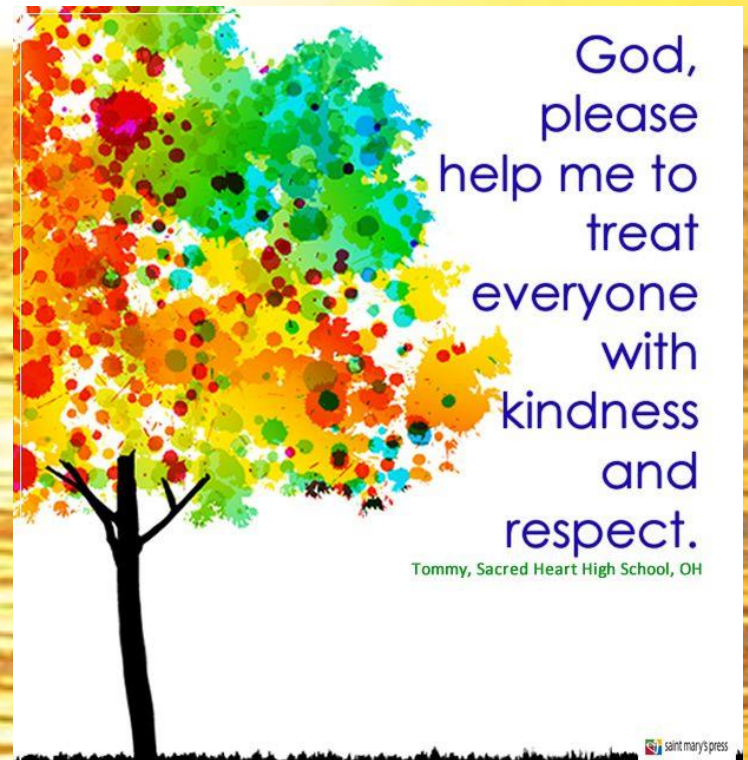





Dear God,

always show respect.

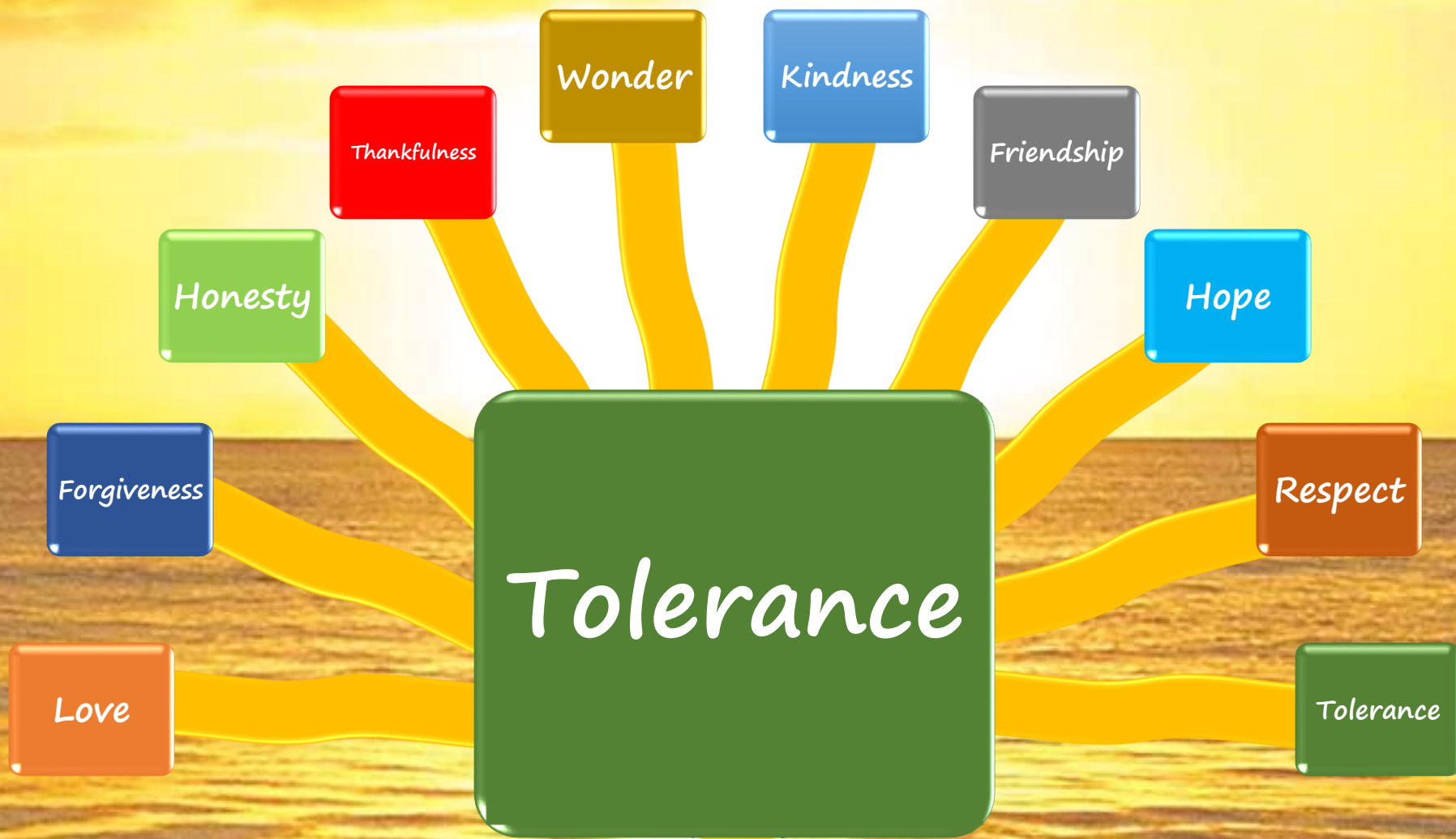
